The program's efforts in improving hygiene, checking for illnesses, and providing health education have played a key role in ensuring that the children grow up in a safe and healthy environment.

The financial support provided to these children has significantly reduced the burden on their families, particularly mothers who face the challenge of raising children without the support of both parents. The monthly financial assistance provided by the program has been a crucial resource for ensuring access to medical care, educational expenses, and other necessities such as school supplies. This support has not only made a practical difference in the children's lives but has also been a source of emotional relief for their caregivers.

The program also benefitted from regular family visits and interaction with community members, which has been essential in building trust and ensuring that the program remains responsive to the needs of the children and their families. The feedback and insights gathered during these visits have been instrumental in driving improvements and adapting the program to better meet the needs of its beneficiaries. Furthermore, the documentation of case studies and progress mapping of each child has been an effective tool in tracking development and assessing the impact of the program. Another significant achievement this year was the expansion of the OCSP. An additional 10 orphaned children from Sirpur village and the Komaram Bheem district in Telangana were added to the program, bringing the total number of children under the OCSP to 25. This expansion demonstrates the program's growing reach and its ability to support more orphaned children in need. The program's success in integrating these new children into the initiative reflects the strong community participation and cooperation that have been central to its effectiveness.

Overall, the Orphan Child Support Program has made a substantial impact on both the children and their families over the past year. The positive changes in the children's education, health, and social skills, as well as the reduction in the burden on their caregivers, attest to the program's success. Details for activities undertaken and outcome from April 2023 to MARCH 2024

1. Activities to build life and social skills

1.1 Counseling and Support

Counseling support is imparted to each and every mother in engaging child and in understanding and meeting to emotional and physical needs of the child. An integrated in socio-psychological counseling sessions are imparted on monthly bases when they coming for the monthly stipend disbursement. The secessions will end up with follow-up action and documentation of findings. From April 2018 to March 2019 every month we have done 6 to 7 home visit and done counselling at individual level.

1.2. Activities to improve living conditions of the child

One of the key activities of the Orphan Child Support Program (OCSP) aimed at improving the living conditions of the children is the regular house visits conducted by the program team. These visits, carried out with a weekly frequency, have been crucial in ensuring the well-being of the children and in documenting any changes or progress in their living conditions. Every week, the team selects between 6 to 15 children to visit at their homes. These visits allow the team to engage with both the children and their mothers, providing counseling and support tailored to their specific needs.

The house visits serve multiple purposes. First and foremost, they allow the team to assess the children's living conditions and ensure that their basic needs—such as food, hygiene, and a safe environment—are being met. By interacting directly with the families, the team can identify any challenges or areas where additional support might be needed. This personal interaction also provides an opportunity to offer guidance and advice on child care, health practices, and educational needs.

Counseling during these visits plays a significant role in helping mothers and caregivers navigate the challenges of raising orphaned children. The team works to strengthen their parenting skills and provides emotional support, which can help reduce stress and improve the overall family dynamic. The regular visits foster a sense of connection and trust between the program and the families, ensuring that the children receive continuous support and that their evolving needs are addressed in a timely manner.

Overall, the weekly home visits have proven to be an essential tool in improving the living conditions of the children, providing both practical assistance and emotional support to their families. Through these efforts, the program not only enhances the children's quality of life but also empowers their caregivers to create a more nurturing and stable home environment.

Aunty had joined in school, now able to take care of jyothis's educational needs.

Jyothi Pille a sensitive girl who is aged about 14 years lives with her big mother near Basel Mission School, Hubli, Karnataka.

Jyothi pille from small age underwent many horrible situations, where she had lots of dreams and goals about her future but the family situations made her stay by losing all her dreams. Through kind sponsorship of JEHOVAH JIREH FOUNDATION she is now again coming up and looking towards her goals.

Jyothipille is the only daughter of Mohanpille and Lathapille. She was very sad that she lost her father at her small age, she didn't experience love of her father, but the sad thing is after death of her father mother also left her and went in search of job to look after about future of Jyothi, she left her daughter and now working at hospital as aaya at hospital she stays there itself she doesn't come to look her daughter. Jyothi without parents love she became alone and she was



grieving about her situation. Now she is under the care of her big mother bharathi who takes care about the child from



the time when her parents had been left her.

Jyothi was in a deep sorrow that even though she had her big mother but she was expecting for mother love, the absence of her father and mother made her to feel she was lonely and she was waiting for the days of happiness to come in her life, and also she lost her interest towards studies, as she was under the darkness of family hindrances. She was not able to concentrate towards studies.

She loves to study but no support she had from anywhere, no one was there to encourage support and build her career, this made to loose concentration over studies, she is presently studying at 10th std. of Basel Mission Kannada Girls School Hubli.

Her big mother works at AAYA [non-teaching staff] in the same school. She is also living in a poor condition she doesn't have any other support they both starve for 1 day meal. Big mother earn little incomewhich will not be sufficient for family commitments, and they both will fill their stomach in the school itself. She was not able to afford for child education. Child is interested to build up her career but no proper facilities to go ahead.

At this juncture in the year of 2019 they came to know about Orphan Child Support Program Of Jehovah Jireh Foundation. They were happy to know about

this support as mother was helpless in her child's education from 4 years the kind sponsorship of JJF started to build up child's career when child was studying at 7th std. she joined under the sponsorship of JJF slowly child started to renew her concentration towards her education. She was gifted with school kit and seeing all her facilities, she started to show keen interest towards studies, with the help of monthly monetary support she was able to purchase every needs and she started to get a satisfied education, and she was able to come up in her studies from 4 years after support started to improve year by year and finally she stepped into SSLC she improved with good progress. Mother was very happy to see child getting sponsorship about her improvement in progress. Mother was very happy that concentrating in studies, she is now able to forget about the loss of her parents she is moving ahead with full of confidence over future. its all happened only through the kind sponsorship of JJF.
